Parent Forum Feedback

Thank you to the parents who attended our first termly Parent Forum on Monday. Mr Lees, Mrs Carmichael and Mrs Parry (our new Parent Support Adviser) also attended the meeting.

A wide ranging conversation took place.

- The role of our Parent Support Adviser (PSA)- Mrs Parry spent a few minutes outlining to parents
 what her new role entailed and how she could help parents in a variety of ways. Parents are able
 to contact Mrs Parry through the office and she will shortly have a designated mobile phone
 number.
- Mixed age classes a long discussion took place about how children are placed in the mixed age classes. Mrs Carmichael explained that these classes are always mixed ability with a spread of boys, girls and different abilities and confidence levels. Parents valued having this explained and said that it would help parents to know this before they were informed of classes each year.
 Parents also accepted that it is up to the professionals to ensure the best class placement for their children and parents attending the forum had upmost confidence that the school gets this right.
- **Lunchtime** a parent asked if the children are encouraged to eat their lunch as some children appear to be hungry when they come home. Mrs Carmichael confirmed that all children are appropriately supervised in the school hall and encouraged to eat as much food as they want to.
- **Spelling books** a parent queried whether the spelling books are passed up to key stage 2. Mrs Carmichael has checked with class teachers and spelling books will be issued to all children.
- **KS1 Clubs** a parent said that she thought there not enough key stage 1 clubs this term. Mrs Carmichael said more KS1 clubs will be available in the Spring term.
- **Friends' Presentation of swimming tee-shirts** Thank you to the PTA for providing some fantastic sports shirts for our swimming team!
