Looking for something to do or somewhere to visit this holiday? Here are a few ideas... (The Primary Times magazine is also full of days out!)

*Make some festive shortbread Ingredients

125g/4oz butter

55g/2oz caster sugar

180g/6oz plain flour

Method

- -Heat the oven to 190C/375F/Gas mark 5.
- -Beat the butter and the sugar together until smooth.
- -Stir in the flour to get a smooth paste.
- -Gently roll out until the paste is 1cm thick.
- -Cut into rounds or fingers and place onto a baking tray.
- -Sprinkle with caster sugar and chill in the fridge for 20 minutes.
- -Bake in the oven for 15-20 minutes.
- -Set aside to cool on a wire rack.
