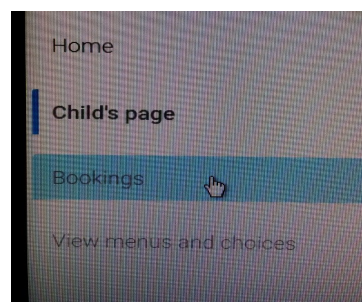

PARENTPAY ERRORS

There has been quite a few queries regarding errors when booking on Parentpay at the moment. It seems to happen when people try to pay first, instead making the booking first. You need to select 'bookings' and go through the procedure this way.



Polite reminder: If your child is off with a sickness or diarrhoea bug, they need to be off for 48hours without any illness, to avoid any further spreading of the bug.
