

Did you know...

In order to reach their Early Learning Goal, children in Reception need to be able to say a sound for each letter of the alphabet and at least 10 digraphs (2 letters which make 1 sound).

Games to try at home!



Letter Collage!

Use paper to make a cut out of the different letters of the alphabet.

Let your child fill the letter with stickers, collage pictures or drawings representing things which start with the letter sound!

Letter Bingo!

Create letter bingo cards for different members of your family (lowercase). You can also find lots of printable cards by searching 'Alphabet Bingo' on Google.

Write the letters of the alphabet on pieces of paper, fold and place in a bowl. Take in turns pulling out a letter and telling everyone what sound it makes. If you have the sound, cross it off on your bingo board!
