HEAD'S BLOG...

I am very excited by the prospect of finally getting everyone back to school!; however, as you can probably imagine, this guidance will take some unpicking so that we can formulate a plan to ensure the safety of pupils, parents and staff. I will share this plan with you all as soon as possible.

I have had a busy week, interviewing for our new Assistant Head of School. I am very pleased to share with you that Tom Hobbs will be joining our leadership team from September. Tom comes highly recommended and has a wealth of experience to offer. We are very much looking forward to welcoming him to our team. Further details of class structure will come out next week.

We will also be sending out your child's report and details of their class and teacher next week. Reports will be sent by email this year as we are unable to send them home via the usual 'satchel post'. This has the added benefits of being secure and saving a few trees! We are aware that there has been some concern about a tummy bug this week. Please be assured that no high temperatures (above 37.8) have been reported and this would not be indicative of coronavirus symptoms. This has been verified with the NHS 111 service and no further action is required at this time. In the meantime, we continue to promote frequent handwashing and continue to clean surfaces regularly to prevent the spread of any infection. If your child does experience sickness and/or diarrhoea, please keep them at home for 48 hours after the last bout and inform our office.

Reading books

Please can we ask that any reading books are returned to school over the next 2 weeks if you are able to do so. These can be sent in with children that are currently attending or can be brought to the main office window.

We understand that this may be difficult for some and understand if you are not able to return them before September. However, if your child is in year 6, we would ask that their book is returned before or on Monday, 20th July.

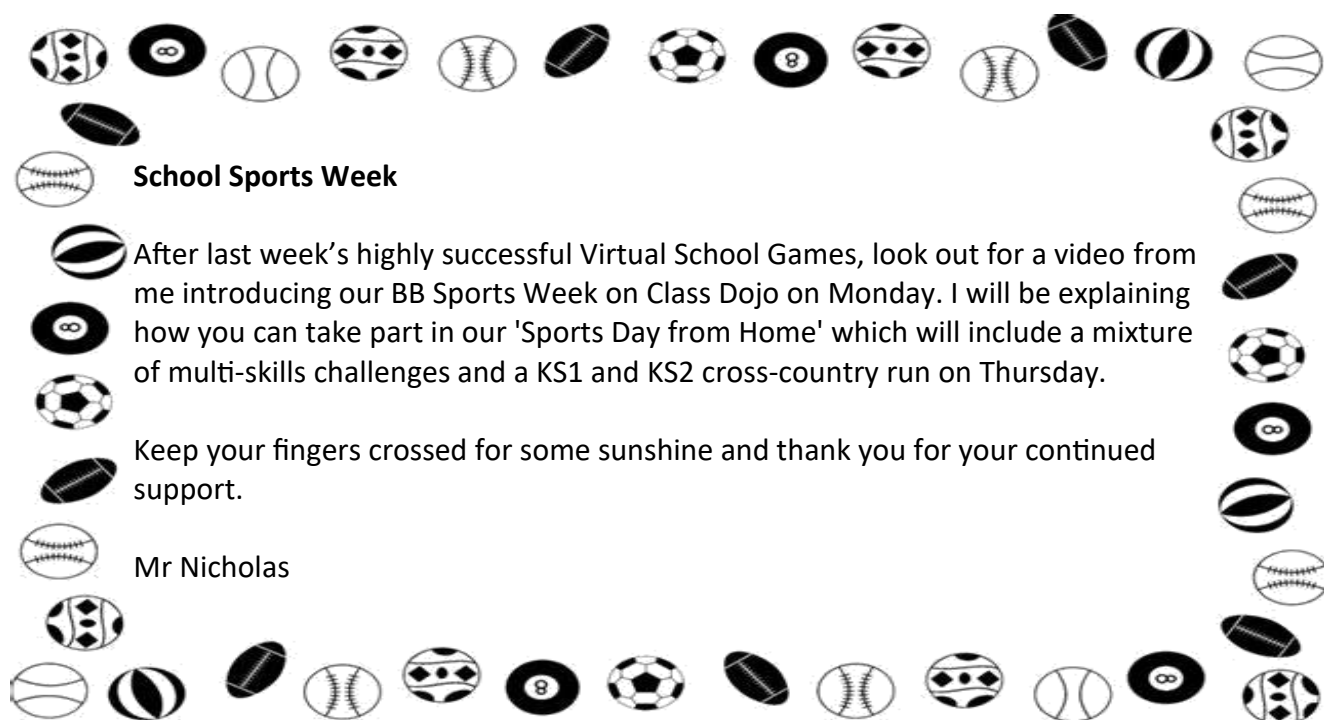

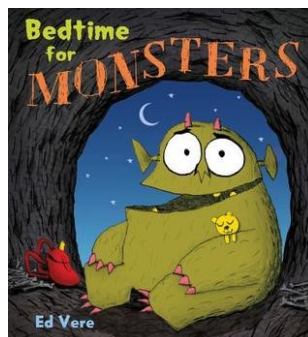
READING...

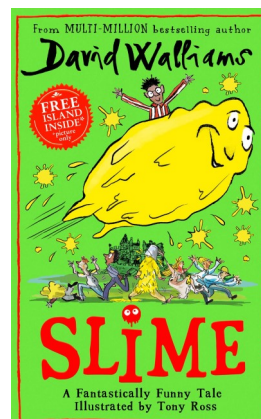

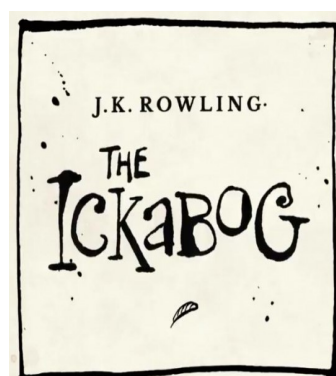
