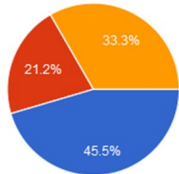

Are you in KS1 or KS2?

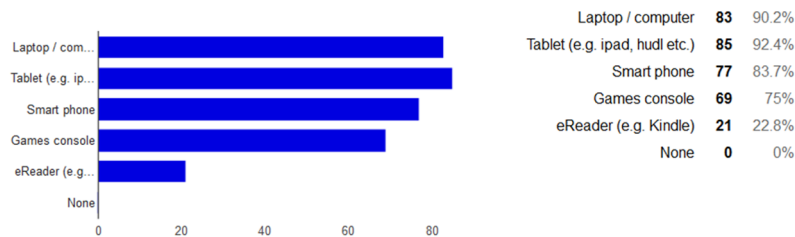
You're in KS1...

Which class are you in?

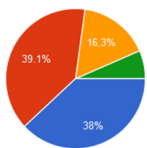

As a family what devices do you have available to use? Tick any that you have.

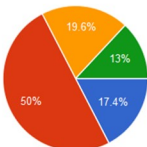


Child: How many hours per day do you go online, including browsing the internet, gaming or using apps?

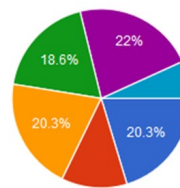

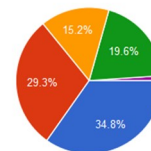

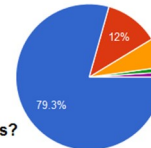
