

	Most bubbles have HLTAs who are able to cover for class teacher if absent. In current lockdown, TAs can operate under direction of a teacher. Supply company will be contacted should need for supply cover arise - they have their own risk assessment and procedures in place and they have copies of our risk assessment. Currently, each bubble has minimum of 2 members of staff per group (some 3). Most could run, with support for breaks, with 1 per group. If staffing levels become too low to maintain supervision, refer to CEO / Directors and LA to consider closing to certain year groups / bubbles. In this instance, remote education would be immediately supplied.





Ensure good ventilation throughout. Avoid sharing of instruments, and clean instruments following use. Use of wind and brass instruments is prohibited. Singing should not take place in larger groups such as school choirs and ensembles,
